
## **Inspection guideline** (Replace if necessary)

## **Purpose and Function**

The drive V-belt varies the speed for the selected gear ratio, delivering engine power to the drive wheel.





## If overused without replacement ...

- · Gear ratio fluctuates
- Belt slipping
- · Abnormal noise
- Riding is disabled

If worn excessively, the drive V-belt cannot effectively transmit engine power to the rear wheel. If a worn drive V-belt is not replaced, the original range of the CVT setting is exceeded and in the worst case, the drive V-belt breaks the motorcycle which cannot be operated.
