2014 key points

- Japan production volume increased year-on-year owing to the increase in production of mini vehicles.
- Overseas production volume increased year-on-year owing to the increase in countries including India and China.
- Global production volume exceeded three million units for the first time to become the highest ever.

Standard and small vehicles	78,290	99.0%	Down for the second consecutive year
Total	787,370	112.2%	Up for the third consecutive year

2014 key points

- Mini vehicle sales in Japan became the highest ever owing to the Hustler.
- Standard and small vehicle sales in Japan slightly decreased year-on-year, but the total Japan sales of mini, standard, and small vehicles became the highest ever.
