Suzuki 2015 Automobile Production, Japan Sales, and Export Figures (Preliminary, Calendar-Year Basis)

■ Production

	Jan.-Dec. 2015 (units)	Year-on-Year	Year-on-Year Trends
Japan production	937,568	88.5%	Down for the first time in two years
Overseas production	2,096,513	107.1%	Up for the fourth consecutive year
Global production	3,034,081	100.6%	Up for the second consecutive year

*Japan production: Complete built-up (CBU) units + complete knocked-down (CKD) units

*Overseas production: Units completed at overseas plants that exclude CKD units from Japan

2015 key points

- Japan production volume decreased year-on-year owing to the decrease in production for both domestic and exports.
- Overseas production volume became the highest ever, owing to the increase in countries including India, Pakistan, and Hungary.
- Global production volume exceeded three million units for the second consecutive year to become the highest ever.

Minivehicles	559,699	78.9%	Down for the first time in four years
Standard and small vehicles	76,667	97.9%	Down for the third consecutive year
Total	636,366	80.8%	Down for the first time in four years

2015 key points

- Minivehicle sales in Japan decreased year-on-year throughout the whole model lineup.
- Standard and small vehicle sales in Japan decreased year-on-year.

Exports	125,465	84.8%	Down for the fifth consecutive year

2015 key point

- Overall exports decreased year-on-year owing to the decrease in exports to areas including Latin America, Southeast Asia, and Europe.
