## Production

October 2016 key points

- Japan production volume decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in production for domestic market.
- Overseas production volume decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in countries including China and Indonesia, despite increase in countries including India and Thailand.
- Global production volume decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in both Japan and overseas production.

\*Standard and small vehicle: Car that exceeds the above minivehicle specification.

October 2016 key points

- Minivehicle sales in Japan decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in sales of models including the Hustler and the WagonR.
- Standard and small vehicle sales in Japan became the highest ever for October owing to increase in sales of models including the Ignis and the Baleno.
- The total Japan sales of minivehicle and standard and small vehicle sales decreased year-on-year.
