### ■ Production

### October 2017 key points

- Japan production volume increased year-on-year owing to increase in production for both domestic and exports.
- Overseas production volume became the highest ever for October owing to increase in countries including India, Pakistan, and Indonesia.
- Global production volume became the highest ever for October owing to increase in both Japan and overseas production.

\*Standard and small vehicle: Car that exceeds the above minivehicle specification.

### October 2017 key points

- Minivehicle sales in Japan increased year-on-year owing to increase in sales of models including the WagonR and the Spacia.
- Standard and small vehicle sales in Japan became the highest ever for October owing to increase in sales of models including the Solio and the Swift.
