#### March 2019 key points

- Japan production volume decreased year-on-year owing to the decrease in production for exports.
- Overseas production volume decreased year-on-year owing to the decrease in countries including India and Thailand.

Fiscal 2018 key points

- Japan production volume increased year-on-year owing to the increase in production for the Japanese domestic market.
- Overseas production volume became the highest ever owing to the increase in countries including India and Myanmar.
- Global production volume became the highest ever owing to the increase in both Japan and overseas production.

\*Standard and small vehicle: Car that exceeds the above minivehicle specification.

#### March 2019 key points

- Minivehicle sales in Japan increased year-on-year mainly owing to the increase in sales of the all-new Jimny.
- Standard and small vehicle sales in Japan became the highest ever for a single month owing to the increase in sales of models including the all-new Jimny Sierra and the Solio.
