## Production

July 2019 key points

- Japan production volume decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in production for both domestic and exports.
- Overseas production volume decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in countries including India and Thailand.
- Global production volume decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in both Japan and overseas production.

\*Minivehicle: Small-sized car unique to Japan with an overall length of 3.4m or less, an overall width of 1.48m or less, an overall height of 2m or less, and an engine displacement of 660cc or less.

\*Standard and small vehicle: Car that exceeds the above minivehicle specification.

July 2019 key points

- Minivehicle sales in Japan decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in sales of models including Hustler and WagonR.
- Overall, standard and small vehicle sales in Japan decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in sales of models including Ignis and XBEE.
- Total Japan sales of minivehicle and standard and small vehicle sales decreased year-on-year.
