Japan production:

Japan production was 291.4% year-on-year since previous year figure resulted in low level owing to production suspension period in the domestic plants due to the impact of the new coronavirus.

• Overseas production:

Overseas production was 3,273.3% year-on-year since previous year figures resulted in low level including zero production unit in India owing to production suspension period in the plants of each country due to the impact of the new coronavirus.

Japan sales was 167.8% year-on-year since previous year figures resulted in low level owing to insufficient supply of products from decrease in Japan production due to the impact of the new coronavirus.

• Overseas sales:

Overseas sales was 1,306.8% year-on-year since previous year figures resulted in low level including zero sales unit in India owing to lockdowns in each country due to the impact of the new coronavirus.
