#### ▪ Production

Marked record high for December owing to increase in countries including India which marked record high for a single month.

- Global sales:  
Marked record high for December mainly owing to record high overseas sales for a single month.
- Japan sales:  
Decreased year-on-year owing to decrease in mini vehicle sales despite record high standard and small vehicle sales for December.
- Overseas sales:  
Increased year-on-year mainly owing to increase record high sales for a single month in India.

### ▪ Japan sales:

Increased year-on-year owing to increase in standard and small vehicle sales despite decrease in mini vehicle sales.

Standard and small vehicles marked record high yearly sales.

### ▪ Overseas sales:

Increased year-on-year owing to increase in sales in regions including India, Pakistan, and Africa.

India and Africa marked record high yearly sales.
